Ltd. and Uralmashzavod OJSC under the YeRS contract signed on September 21, 2021. Mining operations are ongoing at the site. To date, more than 183.0 million mining works have been completed. Work is underway to develop design documentation for the construction of the new copper concentrator-3 and infrastructure facilities. Wood company was involved in the design work and Worley Parsons company was involved in the technical supervision of the construction. 18.4 million cubic meters (90%) of earthworks, 643.0 thousand cubic meters (85%) of concrete works, 92.2 thousand tons (90%) of reinforcement works have been performed at the construction site. Installation of 11.6 thousand tons (37%) of main process equipment and 19.3 thousand tons (33%) of steel structures was carried out.</p>
